Round 3 Recap: AIG Women's Open

Top Notes to Know From Round 3:

- *67 of last 70 women's major winners were within 4 of lead through 54 holes
- *80% of women's major winners since 2010 have been within 2 of lead through 54 holes
- *Lilia Vu: 21'10" average proximity on approaches from 150-175 yards today (LPGA average: 34'3")
- *Charley Hull: first career 54-hole lead or co-lead in a major championship
- *Hyo Joo Kim: -89 in majors since beginning of 2018 (20 shots better than any other player)

*Lilia Vu was excellent on Saturday on approach shots from 150 to 175 yards, averaging just under 22 feet from the pin. That's more than 12 feet closer than the LPGA Tour average this season from that range.

*Hyo Joo Kim will enter the final round just one shot off the lead. Since 2018, she is a combined 89-under-par in majors, 20 shots better than anyone else. She does not have a major win in that span, though – her major win came at the 2014 Amundi Evian Championship.
