Grass Types and Cutting Heights

Tees, Fairways and Rough:

Tees and fairways are Celebration Bermuda and the rough is Bermuda. Tees are mowed each morning at .450 inches. Fairways are mowed each morning at .450 inches. The rough is maintained at 2 inches.

Greens:

The greens are Tif Eagle Bermudagrass and are being cut and rolled each morning at a height of cut of .100 inches to maintain a speed of 12' - 12' 5".

Approaches / Green Surrounds:

Approaches and Collars are Tif Grand Bermuda. Approaches are mowed at .450 inches each morning. Collars are mowed at .400 inches each morning.

Golf Course and Site Information:

Originally named Palma Sola Country Club, Bradenton County Club is a classic 1924 Donald Ross design. In 1999, Bradenton CC underwent a restoration project lead by Ron Garl. More recently, Hall of Famer and club member, Tony Jacklin, CBE oversaw a 2018 "restorvation" project to the course. The club's Palm Tree logo in use today is adopted from the term "Palma Sola", which means the solitary palm, and this palm could be seen and used as navigation for the ships in the early days to sail into the bay, now known as Palma Sola.
