Final Round Recap: LPGA Drive On Championship

Top Notes to Know From Round 4:

- *Nelly Korda: 9th career LPGA win (2nd-most of any player since beginning of 2018)
- *Nelly Korda: 8-under on 17 and 18 this week; 47.5% of strokes gained total came on those 2 holes
- *Nelly Korda: did not have birdie today until 17th hole (finished regulation eagle-birdie)
- *Lydia Ko: win, runner-up to begin 2024 season (+3.46 strokes gained total per round)

*Nelly Korda now has nine LPGA Tour wins, the second-most of any player since the start of the 2018 season. Only Jin Young Ko has more in that stretch:

*Korda played the 17th and 18th holes in 8-under for the week, including 3-under in the final round. She picked up more than 7 strokes on the field for the week on those two holes alone, accounting for more than 47% of her strokes gained total for the week.

*Through three rounds, Nelly Korda had missed just 5 greens in regulation all week. She missed 5 alone in the final round, but her incredible finish to regulation got her into the playoff:

*Lydia Ko will be disappointed to miss out on the win this week, but she's off to a tremendous start to begin her 2024 season. In eight rounds, she's a combined 25-under-par and have made birdie or eagle on one-quarter of the holes she's played.
