# **Top Notes to Know From Round 3:**

- \*Nelly Korda: led or co-led entering final round in 7 of 8 career LPGA Tour wins
- \*Nelly Korda: 4 rounds with 16+ GIR this season (had 5 in all of 2023 season)
- \*Nelly Korda: 9 top-10s since beginning of last LPGA season (T-2<sup>nd</sup> most among those without win)
- \*Lydia Ko: seeking to become first since 2010 to win first 2 events of LPGA season (Miyazato)
- \*Megan Khang: 8'3" average proximity from 125-150 yards today (Tour average: 28'0")

### Nelly Korda Approach Proximity – 100-125 Yards

\*On four approach shots from 125 to 150 yards away on Saturday, Megan Khang hit it inside ten feet three times. Her average proximity was a staggering 8'3" for the round from that range:

<sup>\*</sup>Korda has been remarkable all week on approach shots from 100-125 yards away, averaging 14'2" from that range. In the third round, she averaged an astonishing 6'4" on her 3 approaches from that distance.
