Round 3 Recap: Amundi Evian Championship

Top Notes to Know From Round 3:

- *Stephanie Kyriacou: 1-shot lead; first career 54-hole lead or co-lead on LPGA Tour
- *Previous 6 players to lead by 1 entering final round of major did not go on to win
- *Lauren Coughlin: made 109 feet of putts in round 3 (made 47 feet in round 2)
- *Ayaka Furue: streak of 67 consecutive holes without bogey snapped on 11th today
- *Ally Ewing: 64 today; -13 in rounds 3 & 4 of majors this year (best of any player)

*Stephanie Kyriacou entered the third round with just a 7.7% probability of winning the Amundi Evian Championship. Her performance Saturday, coupled with Ayaka Furue slowing down a bit, makes her the favorite heading into Sunday:

*Ayaka Furue was bogey-free for the week when she made the turn on Saturday. She made bogeys at 11 and 13 however to end that run:

*After a major-career-best 64 on Saturday, Ally Ewing is now 13-under-par in rounds three and four of the majors this year, best of any player.

*Lauren Coughlin made more than 100 feet of putts on Saturday, fueled by three long makes of 15+ feet. Coughlin made just one putt of 15+ feet in rounds one and two combined.

*Ayaka Furue's streak of 67 consecutive holes without a bogey ended on the 11th hole today. It's the longest such streak on the LPGA Tour this season and the longest by any player on the Tour in '24.
