## **Aon Insight**

The 11th hole at Hoakalei Country Club should provide players with a birdie opportunity to start their back nine. This straight away par-5 features water on the right that is in play for the second shot. Players will need to decide whether to play as a three-shot hole or try and reach the green in two depending on which tee box is in play. The 11th hole at Hoakalei is one of the most difficult par-5's on the LPGA Tour, with the field making birdie 18% of the time. When the back tees were in play last year in rounds one and two, the hole played over par. When playing the front tee location, finding the fairway should give players the opportunity for an eagle putt, while finding the rough or bunker will most likely result in a lay-up. When playing from the back tees, more of the field will need to focus and rely on their wedge game to make birdie.

### **Contender Update**

With just 2 events to go on the Aon Risk Reward Challenge the LPGA Tour heads to Hawaii for the LOTTE Championship.

Despite not being in the field at the TOTO Japan Classic last week, Jeeno Thitikul maintains her lead with an average score to par of -0.900. Her strong showing at the Maybank Championship which included 2 birdies on the challenge hole extended her now sizable lead making her a difficult player to catch.

Haeran Ryu, in second place, improved her average score to par of -0.833 at the TOTO Championship after recording 2 birdies on the challenge hole, while Ruoning Yin follows in third with a score to par of -0.813. Tune into Golf Channel coverage throughout the event to follow the action over the next few weeks and see who is named this season's top decision maker.

#### **Aon's Risk Reward Challenge Scoring**

One hole is selected at each tournament as the designated Aon Risk Reward Challenge hole for the week (hole is strategically challenging in nature).

For every participating event, a player's best two scores on the designated hole counts towards the season-long leaderboard.

The player with lowest average score under par across the regular season wins the Aon Risk Reward Challenge and will be awarded at the CME Group Tour Championship.

#### Aon and the PGA TOUR

The 2024 season will showcase the next evolution of Aon's partnership with the PGA TOUR, which will integrate the use of real-time analytics and capitalize on changes to the TOUR's reimagined 2024 schedule.
