NOTABLE PLAYERS IN THE LOTTE CHAMPIONSHIP PRESENTED BY HOAKALEI FIELD

Ayaka Furue (Rolex Rankings No. 9)

"I like the atmosphere off Hawai'i. Kind of like -- how do I say, it's kind of relaxing style, so I am looking forward to enjoying that atmosphere." – Furue on returning to Hawaii

- This is Furue's third appearance in the LOTTE Championship presented by Hoakalei
 - 2022: T67; 2023: T23
 - Last season at the LOTTE Championship, she ranked third in the field in strokes gained putting, yet ranked outside the top 100 in strokes gained tee-to-green

- This is Furue's 23rd event of the 2024 LPGA Tour season
 - She's made 21 cuts; her lone missed cut in 2024 came at the Dow Championship
 - She is playing her fourth consecutive event; she is coming off a T10 finish at the TOTO Japan Classic
 - She has earned 11 top-10 finishes, including a win at The Amundi Evian Championship
 - Entering the LOTTE Championship, she has holed 163 putts of 10 feet or longer this season, most of any player on Tour
 - She's followed by Pajaree Anannarukarn (160), Paula Reto (157) and Anna Nordqvist (154)
 - According to KPMG Performance Insights, she ranks at or near the top of the Tour in multiple scoring categories

- Furue is currently the highest-ranked player in scoring average eligible for the Vare Trophy, ahead of Haeran Ryu by only 0.011 strokes
 - Jeeno Thitikul (69.537) and Nelly Korda (69.918) will not meet the 70 total official tournament rounds' requirement needed to earn the Vare Trophy
 - There are projected to be 12 official tournament rounds remaining in the 2024 season
 - The Vare Trophy winner's scoring average since its inception in 1953 is 71.294
- This is her third season on the LPGA Tour
 - \circ $\;$ She is a two-time Tour winner, earning her first at the 2022 ISPS Handa Women's Scottish Open $\;$
 - She has earned 43 official top-25 finishes in her career, including 23 top 10s

 - She was a member of Team Japan in the 2023 International Crown

Jin Young Ko (Rolex Rankings No. 10)

- This is Ko's second appearance at the LOTTE Championship
 - o First debuted in 2019 (T17) at Ko Olina Golf Club
- This is her 17th event of the 2024 LPGA Tour season
 - She is coming off a T22 finish at the TOTO Japan Classic
 - Her season-best result is second, earned at the KPMG Women's PGA Championship and the FM Championship
 - She's earned six top-10 finishes this year on Tour
 - Ko is looking for her first Tour victory of the season
 - She has won at least one Tour title since 2017
- Ko is ranked third on Tour in strokes gained approach per round for the second consecutive season.
 - In 2022, she was 30th on Tour in that metric

• She has also gained at least a full stroke with her approach play in 60% of her rounds this season on the LPGA Tour, which is the second highest rate among qualified players

- This is her seventh season on the LPGA Tour
 - She is a 15-time LPGA Tour winner and two-time major championship
 - She last won at the 2023 Cognizant Founders Cup
 - She is a two-time Olympian representing the Republic of Korea (2020, T9; 2024, T25)
 - \circ She represented Team Korea at the 2023 Hanwha LIFEPLUS International Crown
 - She is a two-time Rolex Player of the Year recipient (2019, 2021)
 - She is a 12-time KLPGA winner

Mao Saigo (Rolex Rankings No. 33)

- This is Saigo's first appearance in the LOTTE Championship
- This is her 27th start of the 2024 LPGA Tour season
 - She's made 22 cuts, and has played every LPGA tour event since The Chevron Championship

- She's coming off a T26 finish at the TOTO Japan Classic last week
- Her season- and career-best finish is second, earned at the CPKC Women's Open and Buick LPGA Shanghai
- \circ ~ She has earned seven total top-10 finishes this year
- She enters the LOTTE Championship ranked first on Tour in sub-par rounds (59) and rounds played (93)
- According to KPMG Performance Insights, Saigo ranks 7th on Tour in strokes gained ball striking (+1.23), compared to T71 in strokes gained short game (+0.08)
 - Since June 1, she has been ranked in the top eight on the LPGA Tour in multiple ball striking statistics

- She is a 2024 LPGA Tour rookie
 - She is one of 21 in the field this week in Hawaii
 - She is currently the highest-ranked rookie on the Race to CME Globe (9th)
 - She currently leads in the Louise Suggs Rolex Rookie of the Year with 919 points
 - She has led the standings for the last three months
 - Saigo and Jin Hee Im (788 points) are the final players in contention to become ROTY
 - If Saigo were to win, she would be the second player from Japan to win Rookie of the Year, joining Hiromi Kobayashi (1990)
 - She finished in a tie for second at 2023 Final Qualifying to first earn Tour Membership for 2024
 - She has played on the JLPGA since 2020; she is a six-time winner, and most recently at the 2023 Ito En Ladies Golf Tournament

OF NOTE

- Defending champion Grace Kim is competing in her second LOTTE Championship
 - "[The win] is still a little bit of a blur. Like I can't believe it's probably over a year now. Definitely came back [Sunday] to put my golf clubs in the locker room, and, yeah, trying to look back to the 18th green and going over that twice on the Saturday was, yeah, pretty cool. Just surreal."
 - She won the event to become a Rolex First-Time Winner in her third start as an LPGA Tour Member
 - She averaged +3.35 strokes gained per round from tee-to-green on her way to victory, the most in a single event for her over the past two seasons
 - This is her 27th start on Tour this season
 - She has earned three top-10 finishes, including a season-best tie for second at the Meijer LPGA Classic
 - Two-time LOTTE champion Brooke Henderson (2018, 2019) is making her eighth start in the event
 - "It would be pretty cool to add my name to the record books and be that three-time champion here. I would love that for sure. It's been a little while since my last two victories here. Hopefully this week. Just going out and trying to battle the conditions the wind as best I can and see if I can put myself in contention."
 - Along with her wins, she's notched five top-15 finishes, and has recorded a scoring average of 69.3 (68-under par)
 - \circ The 13-time LPGA Tour winner last earned a victory at the 2023 Hilton Grand Vacations Tournament of Champions
 - She's recorded eight top-10 finishes this season, including three third-place finishes at the 2024 HGVTOC, HSBC Women's World Championship and The Chevron Championship

KPMG PERFORMANCE INSIGHT OF THE WEEK

• Since the move to Hoakalei two years ago, the winners of the LOTTE Championship have gained almost all of their strokes on the field with their tee-to-green play. Putting accounted for less than 6% of the strokes gained total for the week for both **Hyo Joo Kim** in 2022 and **Grace Kim** last year.
