Aon Insight

There's ample opportunity for scoring on the 14th hole at Blythefield Country Club, with players carding birdie or eagle nearly 40 percent of the time last year. To take advantage, an accurate drive is very important: one in three players who miss the fairway lose, on average, more than fourtenths of a stroke. Meanwhile, hitting the fairway makes a player more than three times as likely to go for the green in two. Last year's Meijer Classic winner Leona Maguire hit the fairway all four rounds and gained 3.7 strokes on the field on this hole alone.

What is the Aon Risk Reward Challenge?

The Aon Risk Reward Challenge is a seasonlong competition on the LPGA Tour testing the abilities of the world's best players to make thoughtful, strategic decisions on the most challenging holes ("Aon Risk Reward Challenge holes") throughout the year.

At the end of the regular season, the most consistent player on Tour, with the lowest average score under par, on the Aon Risk Reward Challenge holes captures the \$1 million prize and the Aon trophy.

Aon's Risk Reward Challenge Scoring

One hole is selected at each tournament as the designated Aon Risk Reward Challenge hole for the week (hole is strategically challenging in nature).

For every participating event, a player's best two scores on the designated hole counts towards the season-long leaderboard.

The player with lowest average score under par across the regular season wins the Aon Risk Reward Challenge and will be awarded at the CME Group Tour Championship.

Aon and the PGA TOUR

The 2024 season will showcase the next evolution of Aon's partnership with the PGA TOUR, which will integrate the use of real-time analytics and capitalize on changes to the TOUR's reimagined 2024 schedule.

Aon will headline the Aon Next 10 and the Aon Swing 5, which recognize better decision-making and the elite performance required to break into Signature Events.
