Final Round Recap: Mizuho Americas Open

Top Notes to Know From Round 4:

- *Nelly Korda: 4th player in LPGA history with 6 wins in a season before June 1
- *Nelly Korda: most wins in an LPGA season (6) by American player since 1990 (Beth Daniel, 7)
- *Nelly Korda: 3.29 strokes gained total per round, 75.6% greens in regulation in last 7 starts
- *Hannah Green: top-5 on LPGA Tour this season in birdie or better rate and bogey avoidance

*Nelly Korda is the fourth player in LPGA history to win six or more times in a season before the end of May. The only other player to do it in the last 70 years is Lorena Ochoa in 2008.

*Korda is just the third American player since 1980 to win six or more times in an LPGA Tour season. She is the first since Beth Daniel won seven times in 1990.
