KPMG Insight of the Week

*Over the last two years at this event, players who have finished in the top-10 have gained 51.8% of their strokes with approach play. That's considerably more than the Tour average this season for top-10 finishers, 41.5% --

Lilia Vu

*Lilia Vu has been excellent on the greens overall this season, ranking tenth in strokes gained putting per round. But she's been especially strong since coming back from injury – she's fifth on Tour among qualified players in strokes gained putting per round since June 1.
