### **KPMG** Insight of the Week

\*Over the last two seasons, players on the LPGA Tour have gained at least a full stroke on the field with their approach play in 27.5% of their total rounds. Three players – Rio Takeda, Haeran Ryu and Akie Iwai – have each done that in more than 50% of their rounds in that same span. All three are in the field this week.

## Minjee Lee

\*Minjee Lee finished in solo third place last week in Shanghai, her 11th consecutive top-25 finish on the LPGA Tour. She has finished four straight tournaments double-digits under par, gaining 2.75 strokes on the field per round in that stretch:
