Extended Forecast – Hot and humid conditions are expected through the extended forecast with overnight lows in the mid to upper 70s (mid-20s (C)) and daytime highs in the lower to mid-90s (lower to mid-30s (C)). Afternoon peak heat index values could exceed 100F (38C) given the expected elevated moisture levels. Winds will generally be ESE around 5-10 mph with a few gusts up to 15 mph trending SSE into early next week. Dry conditions are expected through the weekend with increasing chances for tstorms heading into early next week.
