Extended Forecast – Dry but humid conditions are expected to persist through most of the extended forecast, however an isolated shower/tstorm can't be completely ruled out. The hottest days will be Friday through Sunday when peak heat index values during the afternoon are expected to exceed 100F (38C). A chance of tstorms will develop by early next week. Overnight lows will be in the mid to upper 70s (mid-20s (C)) with daytime highs in the mid-80s to mid-90s (30s (C)). Easterly winds tomorrow will trend towards SE by Sunday with some afternoon gusts around 15 mph early in the period trending towards 20 mph late in the period.
