Aon Insight

Coming down the stretch, the 17th hole presents a key scoring opportunity if players can steer clear of water off the tee. Those who find the fairway are twice as likely to reach the green in two. In 2019, the hole proved pivotal, with top-10 finishers gaining nearly half a stroke on the field here alone. Club selection off the tee is critical, as the fairway's left side runs out around 240 yards. Staying short of the water leaves roughly 200 yards to the green, where players will have to navigate a blind shot with several tricky plateaus.

What is the Aon Risk Reward Challenge?

At the end of the regular season, the most consistent player on Tour, with the lowest average score under par, on the Aon Risk Reward Challenge holes captures the \$1 million prize and the Aon trophy.

Aon's Risk Reward Challenge Scoring

One hole is selected at each tournament as the designated Aon Risk Reward Challenge hole for the week (hole is strategically challenging in nature).

For every participating event, a player's best two scores on the designated hole counts towards the season-long leaderboard.

The player with lowest average score under par across the regular season wins the Aon Risk Reward Challenge and will be awarded at the CME Group Tour Championship.

Aon and the PGA TOUR

The 2025 season will showcase the continuation of Aon's partnership with the PGA TOUR, which will integrate the use of real-time analytics and capitalize on changes to the TOUR's reimagined 2025 schedule.

Aon will headline the Aon Next 10 and the Aon Swing 5, which recognize better decision-making and the elite performance required to break into Signature Events. Key elements of the Aon Risk Reward Challenge program have evolved to "Better Decision Breakdown" segments that use emerging technology to provide real-time analysis of player decisions.
