Aon Insight

The 18th hole at The Club at Carlton Woods is a challenging par five that tests decision-making with every shot. The hole features a tee shot framed by tall pine trees and a fairway bunker to the right. Water guards the entire left side from the fairway to the green which is further protected by two green side bunkers. The 18th is the most rewarding par five on the course for players with length off the teedrives over 290 yards gained an average of 0.28 strokes on the field, while those under 250 yards lost 0.18 strokes. In 2024, Nelly Korda showcased the advantage of distance on this hole- two of her four drives traveled over 300 yards which gained her 1.7 strokes on the field en route to her victory.

At the end of the regular season, the most consistent player on Tour, with the lowest average score under par, on the Aon Risk Reward Challenge holes captures the \$1 million prize and the Aon trophy.

Aon's Risk Reward Challenge Scoring

One hole is selected at each tournament as the designated Aon Risk Reward Challenge hole for the week (hole is strategically challenging in nature).

For every participating event, a player's best two scores on the designated hole counts towards the season-long leaderboard.

The player with lowest average score under par across the regular season wins the Aon Risk Reward Challenge and will be awarded at the CME Group Tour Championship.

Aon and the PGA TOUR

The 2025 season will showcase the continuation of Aon's partnership with the PGA TOUR, which will integrate the use of real-time analytics and capitalize on changes to the TOUR's reimagined 2025 schedule.

Aon will headline the Aon Next 10 and the Aon Swing 5, which recognize better decision-making and the elite performance required to break into Signature Events.
