**Today** – Last night’s rainfall has provided increased moisture to the area allowing patchy dense fog to crop up throughout the northern Houston metro. This fog may linger through 830AM before partly cloudy skies begin to take shape in the region. A subtle disturbance moving in from the west will provide another isolated threat for showers and a pop-up storm this afternoon with coverage remaining limited compared to yesterday. S/SE winds will increase this afternoon with a few gusts near 18-20mph.
