Today – Low cloud cover this morning along with light patches of fog are possible through daybreak before partly cloudy skies take over into the late morning. As temperatures warm through the day, isolated showers and storms will again be possible this afternoon from 12PM onwards. Any cells that develop could pose a threat for brief heavy rainfall and infrequent lightning. S/SE winds today will increase near 7-13mph with localized gusts across the course reaching 16-17mph at times. High near 84F.

Extended forecast – A similar day is expected Friday with isolated shower and storm potential beyond 2PM as heating peaks. Coverage will remain spotty but any cells that could near the course would hold potential for brief heavy rain and infrequent lightning. A subtle ridge moving into the area this weekend will help to hold off much of the shower potential each day, with generally partly cloudy skies and continued S/SE winds both days. Gusts Saturday and Sunday afternoon may approach 20-22mph.
