Final Round Recap: CME Group Tour Championship

Top Notes to Know From Round 4:

- *Jeeno Thitikul: lowest single-season scoring average in LPGA history (68.68)
 - *Jeeno Thitikul: highest birdie-or-better average in single season in LPGA history (5.12)
 - *Jeeno Thitikul: first player to lead season birdie average & bogey avoidance since 2015 (L. Ko)
 - *Jeeno Thitikul: only player with 3 or more wins on LPGA Tour this season
 - *Jeeno Thitikul: 2nd back-to-back winner of CME Group Tour Championship (Jin Young Ko)
- *Jeeno Thitikul finishes 2025 with the best single-season scoring average in LPGA Tour history.

Best Single-Season Scoring Average LPGA History

*A look at how incredibly close it was – if Thitikul hits two more shots over the course of the entire season, the record still belongs to Sorenstam.

*Thitikul also set a record for best birdie-or-better average in an LPGA Tour season. She is the only player in LPGA history to average five birdies/eagles per round while playing at least 50 official rounds.

*This is the third consecutive season Jeeno Thitikul has led the LPGA Tour in birdie or better average. The last player to lead that statistic three seasons in a row was Lorena Ochoa in 2006, 2007 and 2008.
