Extended Forecast – Partly cloudy skies are expected tomorrow through Sunday morning with a slight chance of tstorms developing by Sunday afternoon with heating of the day. A chance of tstorms will continue into early next week. Overnight lows will be in the 60s with daytime highs generally in the 80s. Temperatures could briefly touch 90F on Sunday during the afternoon. Light and variable morning winds each morning will increase to 5-10 mph during the weekend afternoons with some gusts on Sunday to 15 mph. Wind gusts Monday afternoon are expected to be slightly higher with gusts around 20 mph.
