Extended Forecast – Scattered tstorms will be possible tomorrow with dry and hazard free conditions setting up for Saturday. Most of the area is expected to remain dry on Sunday, however a slight chance of tstorms will develop with heating of the day. Potential for tstorm activity will increase into early next week. Overnight lows will be from the upper 50s to upper 60s with daytime highs in the 80s. The strongest winds of the period are expected tomorrow afternoon with gusts around 22 mph.
