Today – Partly cloudy skies early will give way to developing tstorms this afternoon as temperatures in the 70s warm into the mid-80s. Tstorms will be capable of localized gusty winds. Winds WSW around 5-10 mph this morning will trend generally WNW this afternoon with some peak gusts around 15 mph.

Extended Forecast – Multiple waves of showers and tstorms will remain possible through much of this week with a slight chance holding on Sunday. Each wave of activity will be capable of localized rainfall amounts over 1", but majority of the totals are expected to remain under 1" for a given wave. Overnight temperatures will be in the 60s with daytime highs ranging from the mid to upper 70s tomorrow and Thursday into the mid to upper 80s later in the period. Afternoon wind gusts are generally expected to be between 15-20 mph near peak heating of the day.
