## Round 2 Recap: Dow Championship

## **Top Notes to Know From Round 2:**

\*Last 3 winning teams of this event trailed by multiple shots entering round 3 \*Jennifer Kupcho: held 36-hole co-lead with Ally Ewing at this event last year (finished 2nd) \*Leona Maguire: T-19 finish last week at KPMG snapped streak of 4 straight MCs \*Scoring average about 4 shots lower Friday than Thursday (four-ball format today)

\*Each of the last 3 teams to win the Dow Championship trailed by multiple strokes through 36 holes:

\*Leona Maguire made 6 birdies and an eagle on her own ball Friday, helping team Irish Goodbye to a second round 60 and the 36-hole lead. While that outburst can be partially attributed to a format that allows players to be more aggressive, it's nonetheless a promising sign for the Irishwoman, who has seen her birdie or better percentage decline in recent seasons:

## **Performance Insights**

\*Yahui Zhang's strength this season has been on the greens, ranking inside the top 10 on the LPGA Tour in strokes gained putting. Her putting from distance in particular has been excellent, leading all players in putting from 25+ feet (min. 10 rounds played):

\*Somi Lee's play has improved in all three categories that make up strokes gained tee to green this season, with her biggest improvement showing with her approach play:

\*The team of Ina Yoon and Sung Hyun Park matched the low round of a day with a 10-under 60 in round two to catapult themselves into the top 10. Yoon has quietly been among the best ball-strikers on the LPGA Tour this season, ranking 3rd in strokes gained in that area:
