COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

- 1st: Gemma Dryburgh and Cassie Porter (Kilted Koalas) shot a 66 in their opening round of alternate shot
 - Recorded five birdies and a bogey
 - Had four birdies in a five-hole stretch (Nos. 12-16)
 - Hit 11 of 14 fairways and 12 of 18 greens in regulation
 - Recorded 27 putts in their opening round
 - This is the second time in Porter's career that she has led or co-led after any round on the LPGA Tour
 - Her last time was following the second round of the 2025 Blue Bay LPGA

- This is the third time that Dryburgh has led or co-led after the first round of the LPGA Tour
 The last time was at the 2024 Amundi Evian Championship
- First time paired together in the Dow Championship, Porter's first time competing in the Dow Championship
 - Dryburgh previously competed in 2022 (paired with Charlotte Thomas, missed cut) and 2021 (paired with Jaclyn Lee, missed cut)
- T2: Six players sit at 3-under

LPGA.

- Jennifer Kupcho and Leona Maguire (Irish Goodbye) shot a first-round 67 playing alternate shot
 - Recorded four birdies and a bogey
 - Hit 11/14 fairways and 13/18 greens in regulation
 - Recorded 28 putts in their opening round
 - First time paired together in the Dow Championship
 - Kupcho's fourth time competing, previous best finish was a win in 2022 partnered with Lizette Salas
 - Maguire's second time competing, missed the cut with partner **Mel Reid** in her previous appearance
- Megan Khang and Lexi Thompson (Biggie Smalls) shot a 67 in their opening round of alternate shot
 - This is their first time competing together at the Dow Championship
 - Thompson is making her sixth start at the Dow Championship with her best finish coming last season with partner **Brooke Henderson**, T8
 - Khang is making her fifth appearance at the Dow Championship; her best finish is T6 in 2019 with partner **Annie Park**
 - Had four birdies and just one bogey on Thursday
 - Hit 11 of 14 fairways and 13 of 18 greens in regulation with 28 putts
- o Yuri Yoshida and Saki Baba shot a first-round 67 on Thursday
 - Yoshida and Baba are making their first start as a duo at the Dow Championship this week
 - Yoshida is making her second start at this event after missing the cut last season
 - Recorded five birdies and two bogeys in their opening round
 - Hit nine of 14 fairways and 11 of 18 greens in regulation with 26 putts
- Somi Lee and Jin Hee Im shot a first-round 67
 - Made six birdies and three bogeys
 - Hit 10 of 14 fairways and 14 of 18 greens in regulation with 28 putts
 - First time paired together in the Dow Championship
 - Im's first time competing
 - Lee's second time competing, previous best finish was T23 in 2024 with partner **Haeron Ryu**
- Jodi Ewart Shadoff and Heather Lin also shot a first-round 67
 - Made five birdies and two bogeys
 - Hit eight of 14 fairways and nine of 18 greens in regulation with 23 putts
 - First time paired together in the Dow Championship
 - Lin's first time competing

- Ewart Shadoff's fourth time competing, previous best finish was T3 in 2023 with partner **Emma Talley**
- Yan Liu and Yahui Zhang are making their first start together at the Dow Championship
 - Liu is making her third start at Midland Country Club and has a career-best finish of 7th with Muni He
 - Zhang is making her first appearance
 - Recorded five birdies and two bogeys in their opening round of alternate shot
 - Hit 11 of 14 fairways and 13 of 18 greens in regulation with 28 putts

QUOTABLE

Cassie Porter (1st, -4) on what her and partner Gemma Dryburgh did well today

"From my point of view, we drove really nicely. We assigned the holes really well. I was on evens, and Gem was on odds. We drove the green on 12, which was nice, and that set up a really nice birdie for Gem. Yeah, we just rolled really well together."

Gemma Dryburgh (1st, -4) on how her and partner Cassie Porter compliment each other's games "Yeah, we obviously have different games. Cassie hits it further than me, and I'm nice and down the middle usually. Like Cassie kind of said, we kind of picked the right holes for each other, and I think we gelled really well. We complemented each other really nicely."

Lexi Thompson (T2, -3) on the highlights from today's round

"I didn't put her in the best of position on some long holes, but she hit some amazing shots and hit some really great putts down the stretch especially."

Megan Khang (T2, -3) on the strategy for tomorrow's round

"I told Lexi I wasn't going to be dumb-aggressive today for her. I might get a little dumb-aggressive if it calls for it. But again, probably not changing too much. It will be nice to play our own balls throughout and try to get into more of a groove. I think overall we played alternate shot pretty well. We kept it pretty loose out there, lots of fun. Definitely had a lot of smiles. I think we're both going to take turns giving each other the green light to go for certain shots that we probably normally wouldn't."

Jeeno Thitikul (T8,-2) on the condition of the course today

" I think it's pretty soft out there after the rain a little bit. Like the greens play softer and also slower a little bit after the rain. Then a little windy and tough pin going, I think for front nine, though. Back nine it's not really, but front nine had -- like No. 2 hard to get in like close."

Ruoning Yin (T8,-2) on if they'll try to be a little more aggressive tomorrow

"Yes, 100 percent. She just said to me on the last hole, if we play four ball I'll use pitching wedge. Yeah, so I think four ball is definitely going to be a little more aggressive because everybody's trying to get low scores."
