Top Notes to Know From Round 2:

- *Somi Lee: 2nd on LPGA Tour in scoring average since May 1 (69.88; Thitikul 69.80)
- *Somi Lee: 2nd career 36-hole lead on LPGA Tour (1st in a major championship)
- *Jennifer Kupcho: 7 birdies today; 4.89 per round in last 3 stroke play starts
- *17 of last 18 LPGA major winners have been in top-5 through 36 holes

^{*36-}hole leader Somi Lee won the Dow Championship with Jin Hee Im two weeks ago in the previous LPGA Tournament contested. There are only three instances in the last 10 years where a player won a major after winning the previous LPGA Tournament on the schedule:

^{*}Somi Lee: won Dow Championship with Jin Hee Im 2 weeks ago

^{*}Since the beginning of May, Somi Lee has the second-best scoring average on the LPGA Tour, less than one-tenth of a stroke behind Jeeno Thitikul:

^{*}Somi Lee entered this week averaging 1.61 putts made per round of 10 feet or longer. She made five such putts on Friday, racking up 143 feet of putts in all:

*Grace Kim has made just one bogey through 36 holes this week. Entering round one, she was averaging more than 3 bogeys or worse per round in 2025:
