Today – Rain showers are likely at the start of the second round with intermittent activity remaining possible this morning. A cell or two may be capable of producing a heavy downpour. A relative lull in the precipitation is expected to arrive around midday. Rain and embedded thunderstorms will then become increasingly likely during the late afternoon and early evening as a cold front swings into New England. South-southwesterly winds of 8-15 mph will occasionally gust near 18 mph this afternoon. The temperature is forecast to reach a high in the mid-70s. **Sunrise: 6:08am / Sunset: 7:23pm Forecast rainfall: Averaging 0.25" – 0.50", with locally higher totals around 1" possible.**
