Extended forecast – Partly cloudy skies are forecast on Wednesday with a stray shower becoming possible in the afternoon. Dry conditions are likely on Thursday with temperatures climbing into the upper 70s under partly cloudy skies. Showers will become possible ahead of a cold front Friday morning. Anticipate likely chances for rain and scattered thunderstorms Friday afternoon as the cold front sweeps into New England. A few showers could linger into Saturday morning before activity becomes isolated for the remainder of the weekend. Temperatures will top out in the mid-70s Friday through Sunday.
