**Extended forecast** – Dry conditions are likely on Thursday with temperatures climbing into the mid-70s under a mix of sun and clouds. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms will become possible after 9-10am Friday morning ahead of a cold front. Rain will become likely along with a scattered coverage of thunderstorms Friday afternoon as the cold front sweeps into New England. A few showers could linger into Saturday morning before activity becomes isolated for the remainder of the weekend. Temperatures will top out in the mid-70s Friday through Sunday.
