- Co-Leader: Nanna Koerstz Madsen shot 6-under 65
 - \circ Scored eight birdies, two bogeys
 - Started on Hole 10, made five consecutive birdies on Nos. 16-2
 - Leads field in birdies
 - Hit 6/14 fairways, 14/18 greens in regulation with 25 putts
 - Recorded two sand saves
 - Was 8-for-8 putting from 5-10 feet Thursday
 - \circ 65 ties her lowest opening round on LPGA Tour
 - Last time she shot first-round 65, she won the 2022 Honda LPGA Thailand

- o 65 is her lowest round since round two of 2024 Meijer LPGA Classic for Simply Give; she shot 64
- First first-round lead or co-lead in LPGA Tour career
- In 2024, shot opening-round 66 at Bradenton Country Club; finished T23

- Co-Leader: <u>Jennifer Kupcho</u> also shot 6-under 65
 - \circ $\;$ Recorded seven birdies and one bogey
 - Started on No. 1, recorded her lone bogey on No. 3; went bogey-free on the back-nine
 - \circ Hit 9 of 14 fairways, 15 of 18 greens in regulation with 26 putts
 - Recorded one sand save
 - \circ Her 65 is her lowest opening round since the 2023 Honda LPGA Thailand
 - Her career-low is 63 at the 2022 Meijer LPGA Classic
 - Ninth time leading or co-leading after the first-round
 - When leading or co-leading after the first round, she has recorded six top-three finishes, including three wins
- T3: Americans <u>Angel Yin</u> and <u>Lauren Coughlin</u> and Korean golfer <u>Jin Hee Im</u> shot 66
 - Yin went bogey-free with five birdies
 - One of five players to go bogey-free Thursday
 - First bogey-free round of season and 26th in career
 - Made 20-foot par save on No. 14
 - Hit eight approach shots to 15 feet or closer in round one
 - Birdied par-3 11th with tee shot to 2 feet
 - On 13, <u>hit approach shot within 1 foot for birdie</u>
 - Second start of season; finished T18 at last week's HGVTOC
 - Watch her <u>post-round interview</u>
 - Coughlin scored six birdies, one bogey
 - Hit all 14 fairways
 - Birdied No. 10 with <u>approach shot within 5 feet</u>
 - Second start of season; finished seventh at last week's HGVTOC
 - Is making first start with new caddie, Kurt Moskaly
 - Watch her <u>post-round interview</u>
 - Im had seven birdies and two bogeys
 - Bogeyed her first hole of the day
 - Made five birdies in seven holes from Nos. 7-13
 - Scored three birdies in a row on 11, 12 and 13
 - Hit 17 of 18 GIR, tied for best in the field
- Six players are T6 including three-time Founders Cup champion Jin Young Ko (-4, 67)
 - o Has won the Founders Cup at three different courses
 - Has won the Founders Cup every other year starting in 2019
- Bradenton native and Rolex Rankings No. 1 <u>Nelly Korda</u> shot -3, 68
 - \circ $\,$ Made four birdies and a bogey Thursday $\,$
 - Korda is the most recent winner at Bradenton Country Club
 - Won the 2024 LPGA Drive On Championship in a two-hole playoff against Lydia Ko
 - Hit 52 of last 56 GIR on this course following a hit fairway (92.9%)
 - In her last five rounds on this golf course, she has hit more than 85% of her greens in regulation overall

 - o Lincicome capped her round with back-to-back birdies to get to 2-under
 - \circ Swayne is the first player to represent the U.S. Virgin Islands in LPGA Tour history

Nanna Koerstz Madsen (T1, -6) on having a good round in her first of 2025

"I was very pleased with the round. I didn't really know where my game would be at going into the round so I did have a little slow start just with pars, but I think my iron game was the better part today. I did make some good putts here and there, so, yeah."

Jennifer Kupcho (T1, -6) on what her expectations were coming into this week

"I think just in general I'm not as good on bermudagrass as other grasses, so I think kind of last year I learned a little bit more how to chip, how to just better course manage. So I think I just took what I learned last year from all of the bermuda courses that I played how to play to this year."

Angel Yin (T3, -5) on last competing last week and how she feels about her game

"Last week I just didn't score that well, so I kind of finished towards the bottom of the leaderboard. I know if I just keep the momentum up and start scoring and putts start dropping, everything starts to work together, I'll get a good score out of it. Obviously last week was a good, very good intro into the new season. Never played it and I had a lot of fun. Everybody was really cool. So honestly such a great tournament."

Lauren Coughlin (T3, -5) on how she's to take all the success from last season into 2025

"I think a lot of it is just what I'm doing is working in a certain sense. There are definitely still things I need to work on and get better, but a lot of what I do in my full swing, like I've been able to keep it strong for a really long time. So just not making any changes in the stuff I was doing really well, but then working on the areas that I need to focus on and try to get better in those areas, but, again, not neglecting anything that I do really well. I didn't have much of an offseason so I don't think I had too much rust to be honest. My husband and I bought a house or townhouse in Jupiter so I spent the last three weeks down there. Played a lot of golf. We're good friends with Olly and Emily, Olly Brett and Emily Pedersen, so I played a bunch of golf. Just kind of was able to keep a lot of things going."

Jin Hee Im (T3, -5) on how she carries over her success last season into 2025

"Last year I play well and I just think about my miss things, or most thing is the course management because that is all first new course for me. So I just think about that, more different management, like wind or something. So and then I just make my competence of the short putting, and I think swing thing is just make more good seconds. That's all."

Nelly Korda (T12, -3) on how this tournament elevates Bradenton for the golf community

"It's such a big golf community. I think Florida as a as whole. I mean, there is just so much more to see here. You have beautiful Sarasota, Bradenton, Longboat Key, Anna Maria Island. It's kind of like a hidden gem. Bradenton is actually really, really big. People ask me where I live and that I live 45 minutes away and I'm still in Bradenton. They are always very surprised. There is so much to do here I personally think. I was born in
