**Extended forecast** – Dry and comfortable conditions are expected to continue through the day Saturday. There will be a brief opportunity for shower development Saturday night into Sunday morning which warrant low (35%) rain chances during this period. While confidence in rainfall amounts is low, significant impacts still appear unlikely. Winds should favor an east or northeast component each morning, eventually turning westerly or becoming variable as the sea breeze develops.
