**Today** – Cool and dreary conditions are in place across south Florida with overcast skies likely persisting much of the day. Additionally, periods of sprinkles or light showers could fall from these clouds, especially during the afternoon. Northeast winds can be expected throughout the day with gusts around 20 mph possible. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.05"

**Extended forecast** – A comfortable stretch of weather is expected across south Florida with mild temperatures and low humidity. The forecast also favors dry conditions much of the week, however a stalled frontal boundary south of the Florida Key will be monitored. If this front gets dislodged northward, the threat for rain would increase. For now, a 15-30% rain chance will be included in the weekend forecast to cover this potential threat, with Sunday the more likely day to see rainfall. Winds should favor a northeast component each morning, eventually turning westerly as the sea breeze develops.
