KPMG Insight of the Week

*Over the last two years, players to finish in the top 10 at the Hilton Grand Vacations Tournament of Champions have gained a higher percentage of their strokes off the tee (19.6%) and around the green (19.1%) than is normally seen week-to-week on the LPGA Tour.
