## Day 2 Recap: Hanwha LIFEPLUS International Crown

## **Top Notes to Know From Day 2:**

- \*United States: 21 holes won this week; trailed after just 5 of 62 holes played so far
- \*Noh/Yin (USA): combined to make birdie or better on 15 of 28 holes played through 2 matches
- \*World Team: unbeaten this week (2-0-2); 3 of 4 matches have reached the 18th hole
- \*Thailand: 1-3-0 through 2 days; went 4-0-0 across the first two days in 2023 victory

\*The United States 4-0-0 start is just the third instance of a team winning each of their first four matches at this event. Each of the first two came in 2023 at TPC Harding Park, when Thailand and Sweden each started 4-0-0 with Thailand eventually going on to win:
