COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

- Sixty-six players made the cut at +4
 - Notable players to make the cut are:
 - England's **Charley Hull**, the top-ranked player in the field
 - 2016 Lorena Ochoa Invitational winner **Carlota Ciganda**
 - Mexico's **Maria Fassi**
 - Eight of the 16 LPGA Tour rookies in the field
 - Notable player to miss cut are Mexico's **Gaby Lopez** and **Isabella Fierro**, 2025 Tour winner and World No. 17 **Rio Takeda** and standout rookie and World No. 24 **Ina Yoon**
 - Of the eight Mexicans golfer in the field, Fassi was the only one to make the cut

- Fassi shot an even par 72 on Friday and is +3 total
 - She was +4 after a bogey on 17 Friday, but birdied her final hole to move further into the cut line
- Leader: **Jenny Bae** shot two rounds of 69 on Thursday and Friday, and is -6 overall
 - On Friday, made five birdies and two bogeys
 - Hit 9/14 fairways and 11/18 greens with 27 putts
 - Is T1 in birdies across the field, with 11 overall
 - This is her first post-round lead on the LPGA Tour
 - Her two-day 138 is second-lowest 36-hole score on Tour
 - She shot 138 on one previous occasion, at the JM Eagle LA Championship presented by Plastpro, ultimately finishing T11
- T2: LPGA Tour rookie **Miranda Wang** shot a 7-under 65 on Friday
 - It is the lowest score of the week so far, besting Thursday's low score of 68 shot by four players
 - She went bogey-free on Friday, one of just two players to do so along with **Gemma Dryburgh**
 - Has four bogeys overall, tied for second-least in the field
 - Made seven birdies, on Nos. 2, 5, 6, 11, 13, 14, 18
 - T1 in birdies on Friday, with **Gabriela Ruffels**
 - Hit 11/14 fairways and 14/18 greens with 25 putts
 - This is her second 65 of her rookie season and her career-low score
 - Also shot 65 in her opening round at the JM Eagle LA Championship presented by Plastpro, ultimately finishing T32
- T2: **Brianna Do** shot 71 on Friday and is -5 overall
 - Scored five birdies, two bogeys and a double bogey on Friday
 - Has four bogeys overall, tied for second-least in the field
 - Hit 10/14 fairways and 14/18 greens with 30 putts
 - Is T2 in greens in regulation overall, hitting 28/36, along with Dryburgh
 - The only player better in the field is **Charley Hull** with 29/36
 - Is also third among the field in fairways hit, with 22/28
 - Held the first-round co-lead after shooting a 4-under 68 on Thursday
 - This is her first LPGA Tour start in 2025, and since the 2024 Kroger Queen City Championship presented by P&G
 - Has not made a cut on Tour since the 2023 CPKC Women's Open
 - Do plays primarily on the Epson Tour, with four starts in 2025
 - Has missed the cut in her last two starts
 - Best finish this season is T22 at the IOA Championship presented by Morongo Casino Resort and Spa
- Five players are T4 at -3 overall including;
 - First-round co-leader and Korean golfer **Jenny Shin**
 - Is T1 in birdies among the field with 11 overall
 - Koreans **Hye Jin Choi** and **Jeongeun Lee5**
 - People's Republic of China's **Jing Yan**
 - Making fourth start of 2025, with one made cut
 - Australia's **Gabriela Ruffels**
 - Made four birdies in her last five holes Friday
- **Brittany Altomare** withdrew during her second round, but did not give a reason

- **Ana Belac** withdrew prior to her second round due to illness
- **Caley McGinty** withdrew during her second round due to illness
- **Natalie Gulbis** withdrew during her second round due to injury
- Four players withdrew during the first round, **Jennifer Song** (no reason given), **Annie Park** (illness), **Xiaowen Yin** (illness), and **Hee Young Park** (no reason given)

QUOTABLES

Jenny Bae (1st, -6) on what she has learned about herself in pressure situations

"I feel like I handle it fairly well. Definitely there is going to be some stress and pressure added to it, but I think as long as I keep my momentum and just try to stay positive on every shot and every hole I think I'll be okay."

Brianna Do (T2, -5) on her mindset this week

"I think I have a different mindset going into this week, just kind of changing my perspective a little bit. I've been working pretty hard playing on the Epson Tour. Had a few tough weeks coming in, and kind of just learning from that and changing my mindset a little bit and my perspective and I think it's gone a long way with playing well for 36 holes out here."

Mirand Wang (T2, -5) on how to be successful on the El Camaleón Course at Mayakoba

"I think this course, there are good opportunities out there, short par-4s and short par-5s. Today what I did well I really took the chances. So I think for a player to have a good round here it's just like the short holes you have to get close and make birdies and the long hole, just make good swings and pars out there."

Gabriela Ruffels (T4, -4) on making four birdies in her last five holes

"I made a good birdie on 14 after bogeying 13, the par-5, and then birdied 16, 17, 18. Just holed some really long putts. 16 was pretty lucky I think. I think it hit the pin pretty hard. I think that was going a little bit past the hole, but I will take it. Yeah, made a good putt on 17 and hit it pretty tight on 18 to finish."

Hye-Jin Choi (T4, -4) on the difference between her round today and yesterday

"I mean, today was similar like yesterday. It wasn't really great shots, so I feel really tough day. But if I missed like fairway or rough, I make lots of par save. That's why I still make under par, so I mean, it was tough but it was good."

Jing Yan (T4, -4) on her game over the past two days

"The fairways are really tight so you want to try and keep it on the fairway and then give yourself a good look for the second shot. If you're playing strategic golf, you're good to go... I think I got around strategically even though I didn't have my best stuff. I think I made a couple good putts so I think that was it for me today."

Carlota Ciganda (T10, -3) on what makes the course difficult

"Yeah, it's really narrow off the tee. There is a lot of wind that you can't really feel much on the tee, so you have to commit to those lines and I think it can get tricky. Then the greens, you have some grain so they are slower than what we are used to, so you have to hit it a bit harder. It's just a course I have to be really focused on each shot. It's tricky out there, especially with the wind when it picks up. Yeah it's fun. You can also go on a little run and make a few birdies."

Maria Fassi (T47, +3) on making the cut with a birdie on 18 in her home country

"Yeah, honestly extremely proud of the work I did out there today. Obviously super happy I get to play two more days in Mexico. But just in general I'm happy I get two more days to go at it obviously preparing for the U.S. Women's Open next week. I think it's such a great test of golf. I just wanted to keep seeing it and keep seeing good golf shots. So, yeah, like you said, tough break there on 17, but it just kind of ignited a little fire in me knowing I could get to 18, and closing with that birdie in front of the crowds, it was, yeah, very emotional and special for me."
