Today – Waves of showers will be in place over the region today with temperatures remaining relatively steady in the upper 50s to lower 60s. While the tstorm threat is low, the main concern will be heavy rainfall leading to areas of flooding. Some isolated areas could see over an inch of total rainfall. Winds will persist NNE with gusts between 15-20 mph throughout the day.

Extended Forecast – Decreasing showers will evolve overnight into tomorrow morning giving way to partly cloudy skies most of the day tomorrow. A slight chance of showers is expected to come to an end by 9am tomorrow morning. Dry and hazard free weather will then continue Sunday into early next week with mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies in place. Overnight lows will be in the 50s with daytime highs in the lower to mid-70s. The strongest winds of the period will occur tomorrow when NW gusts around 25 mph are expected.
