Extended Forecast – An organized low pressure system will bring widespread rainfall across the region throughout the day on tomorrow. Several waves of rain could become heavy at times. Total accumulations are expected to be between 0.75" – 1.25". Dry and hazard free weather is then expected over the weekend with partly cloudy to mostly sunny skies. Overnight lows will be in the 50s with daytime highs in the 60s tomorrow climbing into the 70s over the weekend into early next week. Wind gusts are expected to stay at or under 20 mph during the period.
