Afternoon/Overnight – Partly cloudy skies early will give way to a slight chance of showers this evening with most activity expected to remain to the north. Partly cloudy skies are then expected by tomorrow morning. Highs this afternoon will be in the mid-70s with winds SW around 5-10 mph. Temperatures will drop to near 60F by tomorrow morning with light and variable winds.

Extended Forecast – Partly cloudy skies most of the day tomorrow will give way to a chance of developing tshowers during the evening and overnight hours. Rain showers are likely Friday morning into the early afternoon with decreasing coverage expected through the afternoon. Locally heavy rainfall will be a threat with this activity with some areas potentially seeing over an inch. Partly cloudy skies are then expected over the weekend into early next week as high pressure moves across the region. Overnight lows will generally be in the mid to upper 50s with daytime highs ranging from the mid-60s to mid-70s.
