• Since last year's event, approximately half of the 110 bunkers on the course have been upgraded to the Better Billy Bunker System.

• The bunker project will continue and will be complete in the winter 2025-26.

• The land was a Brown Field, which included an oil refinery, warehouses and former United States Armory Depot and Interment Camp during both World Wars.
