# KPMG Insight of the Week

\*The top-eight players in stroke play at this event last year (so the players who advanced to the match play portion of the tournament) gained 41.4% of their strokes on the greens. That's a higher rate than other top-eight finishers throughout the 2024 season. A breakdown:

# Nelly Korda

\*Nelly Korda has been extremely successful in match play events throughout her career, with a combined 16-6-2 record in this event, the Solheim Cup, and the International Crown:

\*Nelly Korda is putting at an extremely high level through her first 3 starts of 2025, gaining well over a full stroke per round on the greens. It's been a steady area improvement for Korda since 2023, an ominous sign for the rest of the field as the LPGA's best keeps getting better:

## **Jeeno Thitikul**

\*Jeeno Thitikul has been on an absurd run over her last 11 starts on the LPGA Tour, finishing inside the top 5 eight times during that stretch. She is averaging over 3 strokes gained per round and making birdie or better more than 30% of the time over those 11 starts, with a scoring average below 68.

# **Charley Hull**

\*Charley Hull has done an excellent job at keeping bogeys off the card this season, making bogey or worse at just over an 8% rate. She also has 3 bogey-free rounds through 3 starts this season, the same number she had in all of 2024:
