Day 3 Recap: T-Mobile Match Play presented by MGM Rewards

Top Notes to Know From Day 3:

- *Only 4 of the top 16 seeded players advanced to the knockout stage - second fewest in event history
- *Jeeno Thitikul: Highest seed to advance; Has only trailed for one hole between her first 3 matches
- *Brooke Henderson: Did not trail at any point during group play; only lost 3 holes so far this week
- *Lauren Coughlin/A Lim Kim: Have had all 3 matches go to the 18th hole so far this week
- *Nataliya Guseva: Lowest seeded player to advance at number 50; won final 3 holes today to defeat Valenzuela and advance

*Only 4 of the top 16 seeded players advanced to the knockout stage this weekend, led by second ranked Jeeno Thitikul. That is the second fewest in the four editions of this event with the round robin format, just ahead of 2022 (2024 did not use the round robin format):

*Second seeded Jeeno Thitikul has trailed only for only 1 hole so far this week, taking a perfect 3-0-0 record into the knockout round. She has played just 45 total holes throughout her first 3 matches, the second fewest of any player to advance:

*Brooke Henderson has been simply dominant so far, never trailing at any point during her first 3 matches. She has won 16 of the 36 holes she has played so far this week and only lost 3:

*A Lim Kim continued her strong play to start the year, going 3-0-0 in the round robin stage. Her strokes gained numbers are up across the board in 2025, with her biggest gains coming in her approach and around the green play:
