### Day 5 Recap: T-Mobile Match Play presented by MGM Rewards

#### Top Notes to Know From Day 5:

\*Madelene Sagstrom: 46th seed entering week; highest seed to win in tournament history

\*Madelene Sagstrom: 11 career match wins in this event (T-2nd most all-time)

\*Lauren Coughlin: 127 holes played this week (most of any player)

\*Lauren Coughlin: trailed then won or took lead in each of last 5 matches this week

\*Entering the week as the 46th seed, Madelene Sagstrom became the highest seeded winner in the history of this event. It continues a string of underdog winners in the round robin format, with each of the last 3 winners in this format holding the 35th seed or lower:
