Today – Isolated showers/drizzle are noted to the west of the course this morning and additional coverage is possible through the mid-afternoon timeframe. **Gusty winds nearby these showers will remain a possibility with peak gusts upwards of 30mph at times within/just outside of shower activity. Outside of shower activity, N/NW winds between 8-14mph may gust near 20mph at times today. A very slight chance for a rumble of thunder is possible after 12PM especially within the mountainous terrain to the east of the course although the threat remains slight.**

Extended forecast – The unseasonably cool conditions across the area today will linger into tomorrow. Departing energy aloft will take its time to work eastward which will allow for a very slight chance for spotty drizzle through Thursday. High pressure beginning to build into the area overnight into Friday will enhance N/NW winds with gusts locally upwards of 22-25mph at times both Friday and Saturday. Conditions will wane into Sunday.
