## **Notable**

- Area has been hot and dry this summer and should result in firm and fast conditions.
- The spring and early summer were very wet, especially in May and June. The rain stopped for most of July and August, but there was one rain event on July 17<sup>th</sup> with 7" or rain overnight that created two large sinkholes in No. 2 fairway and the No. 9 fairway bunker.
- The property was used as a pig farm prior to the golf course being built.
- This is Turpin's 19<sup>th</sup> LPGA event, which is the most hosted by a superintendent on tour this year (see stats on later pages).
