Today – Some light drizzles/showers from overnight will remain in the area in the morning leading to a few possible quick sprinkles. Towards the afternoon, some breaks in the clouds are possible. Any sunshine will aid in increasing the temperatures to near 70 F (low 20s C). Winds will start the day breezy with sustained winds near 20 mph (32 km/hr) with wind gusts in the upper 20s mph (low 40s km/hr).

Extended Forecast – A cold front is expected to impact the area overnight Wednesday and through early Thursday morning. Ahead of this front, during the afternoon Wednesday, and then behind it, during the day Thursday, there are low-end chances of additional showers, with the highest chance overnight. Friday during the day will see a brief wave of moisture move over and may lead to a few quick drizzles. Periods of sunshine each day are possible, but the best chances of warm and sunny weather come on the weekend. Winds will remain breezy through the middle part of the week with the above-mentioned cold front, though wind gusts are not expected to exceed 30 mph (48 km/hr) this week. Weaker winds are expected Saturday and Sunday.
