Today – A very similar day to yesterday is expected today with mostly dry conditions. As a cold front slowly approaches the region, moisture levels are expected to increase. This may lead to a drizzle or two, but otherwise a mix of sun and clouds is likely. Temperatures will warm quickly into the low 70s F (low 20s C) during the late morning and into the afternoon. Winds will be weaker today. Sustained winds should stay in the low 10s mph (upper 10s km/hr) with wind gusts near 20 mph (32 km/hr). Wind gusts will be infrequent throughout the day. In the afternoon, the southwest winds will begin to turn out of the west. After 1900, the cold front will likely bring some rain showers to the area leading into Thursday morning. **Rainfall: 2-4mm through Thursday AM | Sunrise: 0521 / Sunset: 2114**

Extended Forecast – The cold front from overnight Wednesday will clear the area early Thursday morning, but may lead to a few lingering light showers throughout Thursday. Any measurable precipitation is expected to clear the area by 8am, leaving just a shower/drizzle. Friday during the day will see a brief wave of moisture move over and may lead to a few quick drizzles. Periods of sunshine each day are possible, but the best chances of warm and sunny weather come on the weekend. Winds will remain breezy through the middle part of the week with the above-mentioned cold front, though wind gusts are not expected to exceed 30 mph (48 km/hr) this week/weekend. Weaker winds are expected Saturday and Sunday. Into next week rain showers are expected to begin the week.
