Today – The morning will begin partly cloudy, but cloud cover is expected to increase throughout the morning into the afternoon. Dry conditions will prevail throughout the day. Temperatures will be a touch warmer today in the upper 60s F (near 20 C), but winds will be much less breezy today. Swirling winds are possible at times, but generally winds will begin out of the east-southeast and end out of the west to northwest turning clockwise throughout the day.

Extended Forecast – A low-pressure system is expected to bring rain to the area this week. The highest chance of sustained rain is on Tuesday, whereas Monday and Wednesday appear as move patchy showers with breaks between. Later in the week, much lower chances of a shower or two are possible. A few millimeters of rain are possible each day, but Tuesday will likely see the most rainfall out of any day. Temperatures will be warmer in the rain though than last week, with temperatures consistently near 70 F (21 C). Wind direction will vary each day, but speeds will remain similar sustained in the low-mid 10s mph (upper 10s- low 20s km/hr) with wind gusts near 20 mph (32 km/hr). Wednesday will be the most breezy.
