COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

- Winner: **Lauren Coughlin** shot a final-round 72
 - One of 24 players (of 73 that made the cut) to record a round of even par or better on Sunday
 - Started the final round with a one-shot lead
 - Birdied the first hole, never having less than a two-shot lead the rest of the day
 - Her lead extended to six strokes at its peak from Nos. 8-9, 15-16
 - Led the field in birdies with 18 made throughout the tournament
 - Led the field in most greens in regulations hit with 52 of 72 hit through the week
 - Was one of two players to record two or more rounds in the 60s this week including N. Korda
- T2: **Leona Maguire** and **Nelly Korda** finished five shots behind Coughlin
 - Maguire shot a final-round 71
 - This is her best finish since the 2024 T-Mobile Match Play presented by MGM Rewards, also hosted at Shadow Creek; she lost the final match to N. Korda
 - Never recorded a round in the 60s this week; one of two players that finished inside the top 5 to do so

- Korda recorded a 75 on Sunday
 - This is the third consecutive event on the LPGA Tour she has finished as runner-up including the Fortinet Founders Cup, Ford Championship presented by Wild Horse Pass and the Aramco Championship
 - The last player to finish as runner-up in three consecutive weeks was Lorena Ochoa in 2006 -- she finished tied for second across the Ginn Clubs & Resorts Open, Franklin American Mortgage Championship, and Michelob Ultra Open (end dates 04/30/2006 - 05/14/2006)
- **Ruoning Yin** shot the round of the day with five-under par
 - 67 is the lowest round recorded during the 2026 Aramco Championship
 - Only four players including Yin shot a 67 this week
 - Yin was the only player to record a 67 in a round other than the first round

[Rolex Rankings No. 32 Lauren Coughlin](#)

- First start at the Aramco Championship, fourth start at Shadow Creek
 - 2025 – Runner-Up, 2024 – T32, 2023 – T17
 - All starts came at the T-Mobile Match Play presented by MGM Rewards
 - In 2024, three rounds of stroke play were played to determine those competing in match play over the weekend
- 2026: Four cuts made in four starts with one win
 - Has a season-best non-win finish of T27 at the Hilton Grand Vacations Tournament of Champions
 - Surpasses the \$500,000 mark in official season earnings for the third consecutive season
 - Crosses the \$4.5 million threshold in official career earnings and moves into 112th on the all-time money list
 - Would tie her highest Race to the CME Globe ranking at eight
- Career: Three wins, 17 top 10s with \$4.5M in official career earnings
 - Became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the 2024 CPKC Women’s Open
 - Won the ISPS HANDA Women’s Scottish Open later that season
 - Competed on the 2024 U.S. Solheim Cup and the 2025 U.S. International Crown teams

QUOTABLE

Lauren Coughlin (1, -7) on getting her first win in the United States

"I think it just means more because after 2024 and not -- winning is hard and I didn't get it done earlier in the year last year when I had a couple chances and that really bothered me.

I was like, what if I don't ever get to do it again? What if that's the best golf I every played in 2024? Those thoughts were hard not to think last year. So Grant Thornton, people keep not giving me credit for Grant Thornton. I'm a PGA TOUR winner, you know? (Laughing.) So winning Grant Thornton was really nice, too, kind of having to make some putts coming down the stretch there and hitting some shots. Yeah, I think it definitely means more just because you never know if you're going to get the chance again. I was lucky enough to get it done."

Nelly Korda (T2, -1) on her round and what she told herself coming into today

"Honestly just to stay patient, take my chances when I could. I just didn't play good golf today. I was hitting it pretty poorly off the tee and just finding myself in really tough positions going into the greens, and then hitting it in places where I shouldn't be around the greens. It was quite hard to make an up and down. I mean, I just made a birdie, my only birdie, on 18. It's quite tough. This golf course is brutal, especially if you're on the wrong side of the green."

Leona Maguire (T2, -1) on how she would asses her week

"Yeah, I mean, any time you can shoot three rounds under par at Shadow Creek you're pretty happy. I mean, it's obviously somewhere I've done well in the past and predominantly match play, but the stroke play the one year we did it. I've always said it's one of my favorite venues of the year. I felt like my game had been a lot better lately than some of the scores I shot, and it was nice to see that sort of come to fruition this week on really the hardest course I played all year. Yeah, really, really positive week and, yeah, really enjoyed the test that was Shadow Creek."
