COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

- Winner: **Mi Hyang Lee** earns her third LPGA Tour victory at the Blue Bay LPGA
 - Shot a 1-over 73 in the final round
 - Made five birdies, two bogeys, and two double bogeys
 - Birdied the 18th hole to win
 - Hit 7/14 fairways, 11/18 greens, and had 27 putts
 - Shot a bogey-free 33 on the back nine
 - This is her second time converting a 54-hole lead into a win
 - Last time was at the 2014 TOTO Japan Classic
- 2nd: **Weiwei Zhang** finished the week with a total of 278
 - Carded a 3-under 69 in the final round
 - Was tied for the lowest round of the day
 - One of 10 rounds under par on the day

- Made five birdies, one eagle, and four bogeys
- Hit 11/14 fairways, 13/18 greens, and had 30 putts
- Moved to No. 8 in the Race to CME Globe
- Finished the week in the highest position among the athletes from the People's Republic of China
- This is the second runner-up finish of her career
- T3: **Auston Kim** and **Aditi Ashok** ended the week with a total of 280
 - Kim shot a 1-under 71 in R4
 - Made four birdies and three bogeys
 - Hit 6/14 fairways, 12/18 greens, and had 30 putts
 - Played her last six holes in 3-under
 - This is her second top 3 result in two weeks
 - Moves to No. 3 in the Race to CME Globe
 - Ashok carded an even par 72 in the final round
 - Made three birdies and three bogeys
 - Hit 9/14 fairways, 9/18 greens, and had 27 putts
 - This is her best result since a T2 finish at the 2024 JM Eagle Championship presented by Plastpro
 - Made birdie on her 72nd hole to move into T3
- Amateur **Yujie Liu** from the People's Republic of China finished 3-under for the tournament
 - She is the only amateur in the field to make the cut
 - Shot a 1-under 71 in the final round
 - Earned a LEAP point with her T12 finish
- Defending champion **Rio Takeda** finished the week in T5 after a final round 73
 - Made three birdies, two bogeys, and one double bogey in R4

[Rolex Rankings No. 83 Mi Hyang Lee](#)

- Wins in her seventh appearance at the Blue Bay LPGA
- Earned her third LPGA Tour victory and her first since the 2017 ISPS HANDA Women's Scottish Open
 - 3,143 days since her win at the 2017 ISPS HANDA Women's Scottish Open
- Is the fourth different winner through four events in the 2026 LPGA Tour season
- Is the 24th player from the Republic of Korea to earn three or more wins on the LPGA Tour
- Surpassed \$6 million in career official earnings

- Surpassed \$400,000 in season official earnings
- Is the first player from the Republic of Korea to win this season
- Is the second Korean player to win the Blue Bay LPGA,
 - Joining **Sei Young Kim**, who won in 2015
- Is her second LPGA Tour win in Asia
 - Won the 2014 TOTO Japan Classic (formerly the Mizuno Classic)
- Career: Three wins, 30 top 10s, and \$6.1M in official career earnings
 - First joined the LPGA Tour in 2012
 - Won the 2017 ISPS HANDA Women's Scottish Open and the 2014 Mizuno Classic
 - Recorded three top 10 finishes in the 2025 season
 - Had a season-best finish of sixth at the Ford Championship presented by Wild Horse Pass
 - Finished No. 50 in the Race to the CME Globe, her best result since 2019 (35)
 - Won the 2012 Epson Classic on the Epson Tour for her first career victory
 - Finished sixth on the Epson Tour Official Money List in 2012, winning the Gaelle Truett Epson Tour Rookie of the Year Award

Mi Hyang Lee (1st, -12) on her feelings after her first win since 2017

“Still kind of a little bit shake in my hands, and was first hole make birdie, but like two double front nine and then finish 4-over so was almost give up, but my caddie just kept telling me keep fighting, fighting. So I really fought, just didn't give up, and then I just got to make a lot of birdie, so I think amazing. Feels amazing, yes.”

Auston Kim (T3, -10) on her week at the Blue Bay LPGA

“So I love playing golf. I love competing. I know that probably going to learn a lot from this week, but it just hurts right now. I'm like really upset. I know that there is a lot of good to take forward moving on, but right now it just hurts. I really felt like I could get it done this week and just didn't happen. I know that's the way that it is with golf sometimes, but I hope moving forward I won't make the same mistakes that I did this week and play better.”

Aditi Ashok (T3, -10) on how she battled back after three straight bogeys on the front nine

“I tried to put myself back in there and make as many birdies as I could. Left a couple putts short on the back nine which I feel like if I gotten them to the hole they might have gone in, and got a couple bounces here and there which could have gone my way but they didn't, and I was on the top of some ridges whereas they could've trickled back towards the hole. So I guess the back nine I was trying to go for three, four, more birdies; made a couple. With the stretch in the middle it was a good finish. Obviously I feel like it was there to make it my week and I didn't really convert it.”

Yujie Lee (T12, -3) on earning another LEAP point

“Yeah, I just feel like really grateful and then super happy that I get to even compete in the two weeks and get to make the cut this week. And then so I wasn't thinking too much of the result because can't really think about all that. I just tried to take one shot at a time and stick to my game plan. That's all I did.”
