Notable

- Area has received a lot of rain; it is the wettest June and July since 1901.
- A big challenge has been winter ice damage on fairway low points throughout course that held standing water during early winter rainfall on frozen ground.
- The 9's are reversed for tournament play.
- Course is Audubon certified since 2014.
- Wildlife on course: Deer, coyote, hare, waterfowl, various rodents and other small mammals, bats, songbirds, woodpeckers, owls, corvids
- A renovation is planned for 2027.
