Today – Throughout today, high pressure will influence primarily dry conditions and mostly sunny skies. Light and variable winds are forecast for this morning before gradually increasing out of the southeast by this afternoon. In the sunshine, temperatures will warm and settle around the mid 20s (C) once again. Temperatures and winds by sunset will begin to decline with dry weather likely to continue.

Extended forecast – Though a passing shower cannot be ruled out Saturday, mainly dry conditions are likely to hold throughout the day. Later Sunday, as an area of low-pressure drifts near the region, chances for scattered rain and isolated storms will increase – primarily after 2pm. Continued chances may linger into Monday morning before gradually decreasing through the day. Outside of precipitation activity, southeasterly flow will persist on Saturday then switch out of the west-northwest for the remainder of the forecast period. Occasional breezy winds are possible though will favor any open areas. Daily high temperatures will persist in the mid 20s (C) with overnight lows in the teens (C).
