Today – Isolated passing showers are likely to progress south of the area maintaining mostly dry conditions and occasional clouds this morning. Light and variable winds are forecast before increasing slightly out of the east-southeast to east-northeast later today. An isolated shower or storm cannot be ruled out this afternoon, favoring after 2pm. Temperatures will once again climb to the mid 20s (C) throughout the day.

Sunrise: 6:22am / Sunset: 8:51pm | Rainfall: Trace-2.5 mm, up to 5 mm in a heavier shower or storm.

Extended forecast – Slight chances for a passing shower or storm will maintain through the end of the week into the weekend before an area of low pressure gradually lifts near the region. This will encourage increased chances of scattered rain showers and isolated storms later Sunday afternoon. Outside of precipitation, winds will flow from the south-southeast before turning back to the west-northwest; any wind gust near 20 mph will favor open areas. Daily high temperatures are forecast to maintain around the mid 20s (C) most days, with the warmest day on Saturday, and overnight lows will settle around the mid teens (C). Slight chances for patchy fog cannot be ruled out, especially on Friday, though any development will burn off through the early to mid-morning.
